HIGHLIGHTS FROM OUR LAST FISCAL YEAR



10,164 volunteer hours across all programs; **8,814** pounds of litter collected and properly disposed of



7,330 trees planted and **1,175** youth educated



2,947 volunteer hours spent restoring Kansas City's wildlands; **127** species of important native seed collected, processed and planted back into the wild



84,000 residents utilized KCMO's community recycling centers, which are managed by Bridging The Gap



14,552 pounds of waste diverted from the landfill through our green events program; with our help **26** businesses started or expanded a recycling program



5 Green Business Network educational presentations and tours, **437** total attendees
