### **Internship Description**

The Social Media Intern will learn about nonprofit work and environmental action and advocacy and then apply that knowledge to create relevant and engaging social media content as a participant on the social media team. There will be a small monthly stipend to support phone and internet use. Work will be primarily remote with infrequent in-office requirements.

### **Primary Projects**

- Support Bridging The Gap’s social media accounts while gaining experience working from a nonprofit perspective on social media platforms including Facebook, Instagram, LinkedIn, Twitter and YouTube.
- Assist with content strategy, planning, writing, editing, production, approval and publishing, and collaborate with program staff across the organization.
- Review social media conversations, activity and organization mentions across platforms, and advise staff about those conversations and trends.
- Compile monthly measurement reports and explore ways to improve performance.
- Gain hands-on experience testing ideas and new functionality

- Curious, creative, proactive and highly responsive
